By Purchase:

From the Georgia Coast and Piedmont Railroad, part of the line from Collins to Brunswick, GA (about 98 mi.) That part of the line from Collins to Ludowici, GA (about 41 mi.) sold, 9/1920 and operated as Collins & Ludowici Railroad. By court decree, January 7, 1921, the trackage from Collins to Glennville, GA sold to carrier.

6.78 mi. by the Collins & Reidsville Railroad, 1895-1896

15.68 mi. by the Reidsville and Southeastern Railroad, 1904-1905

0.54 mi. by the Georgia Coast and Piedmont Railroad, 1906
