Incorporated by bondholders of the former Lebanon Springs Railroad Company for acquiring the property of that company. This property was shut down due to unsafe roadbed conditions on 7/30/1896. The line was reopened in sections beginning with the portion between Petersburg Junction and Berlin, NY on April 3, 1897.
